

Getting from Benito Juarez International Airport to the Mexico City Hilton Reforma Hotel

Taxi booths are at the arrival exit. You will see them after you get out to the street. All taxi companies are alike and charge almost the same; a trip to downtown may cost you around 250-300 pesos (\$12.50 – \$15 USD).

You can purchase your ticket at the booths near the arrival gates in the walkway area.

By taxi turns to be one of the best ways to get to and from Mexico City Airport, since it is located at just 5 kilometers from downtown; that means an average trip time of 20 minutes.

It's very important to pay attention about the distances and times before use the taxi services in Mexico City. In order to use taxi services, passengers must purchase the corresponding ticket in authorized retail outlets.

Scams

We strongly recommend you pick up an authorized taxi and avoid rides offered by non-authorized drivers, since you could be victim of a scam.

In order to avoid scams, we recommend you bring written down your destination.

Location

Taxi ranks are located at the entrance of both terminals: Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 (international and domestic).

Companies

Only taxis by SCT Secretaría de Comunicaciones y Transportes are authorized to provide service at the airport. Currently there are the

following taxi companies offering service at Mexico Airport (MEX): Porto Taxi, Sitio 300, Nueva Imagen, Excelencia, Confort and Yellow Cab.

There are two different options of vehicles available: For 4 passengers or for 8 passengers.

- Ordinary service: Up for 4 passengers
- Business service: Up for 8 passengers

Opening hours: 24 hours.

Fares

Fares at Mexico Airport are regulated by the Secretaría de Comunicaciones y Transportes and posted in a visible place next to the taxi rank.

The usual fare to get to Mexico City downtown is about 250.00 – 300.00 pesos (\$12.50 – \$15 USD).

You can purchase your ticket at the booths near the arrival gates in the walkway area.

Shared Rides

Shared ride service is available to those who wish to share a ride and pay a flat rate to certain destinations if multiple parties are available for the trip. Apps such as Uber may be useful to do so.

Do you tip taxi drivers in Mexico?

People **do** not normally **tip taxi drivers**. However, if a **taxi driver** provides extra service, e.g., loading/unloading your bags or groceries, waiting for **you** while **you** shop, etc., then a **tip** is warranted for the extra effort \$2- \$5 USD (40-90 pesos).

Is there Uber in Mexico City?

Uber in Mexico City is SUPER cheap when compared to **Uber** in New York or the UK. ... If you take an **Uber** from the airport to the **city** center, depending on what time of day it is, it can cost anywhere between 130 pesos and 200 pesos. That means the most you'll spend is just over \$10 USD.

Transfers

If you wish to transfer from and to Mexico Airport on your own, there are several transfer companies available within the airport premises.
